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Open the Book



On the first Tuesday back after Term Break, the Open the Book team came with a couple of questions to ask the children Who of you get on well with your brother and/or sisters? Who of you have ever tricked your brother or sister? A few hands went up! They brought a story from the book of Genesis about two brothers called Esau and Jacob. Jacob played tricks and pretended to be Esau because he was jealous of him.



On Tuesday 11th June, the Open the Book team returned to finish the story of Jacob, known as The Runaway. He ran away from home and had a dream where Angels were going up and down a ladder. 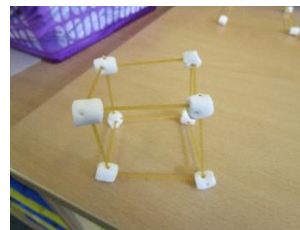
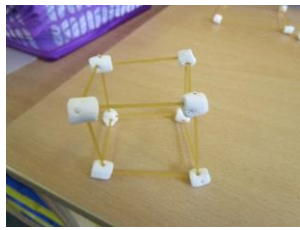
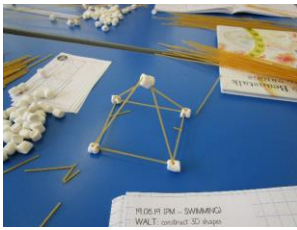
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What else has been happening?

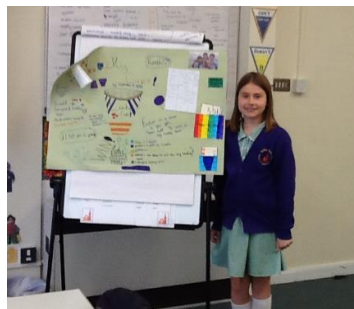


Year 6 Make £5 Grow

Each group then presented their ideas to Mrs Mulley (Acting Head Teacher) and Mrs Williams (School Business Manager), who made the decision (on behalf of Virgin Money) as to whether or not they would lend them the £5 to start their business.

All the groups were successful in securing their loan and the children have found skills valuable for later on in life, for example, being able to use budgets and understand finance, enterprise and entreprenuring.

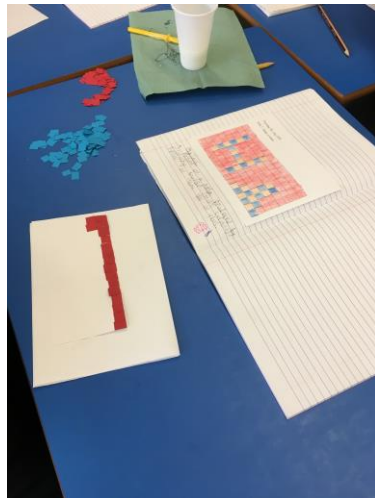
Sports Day

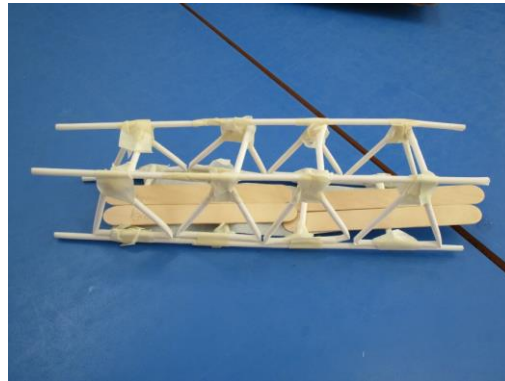
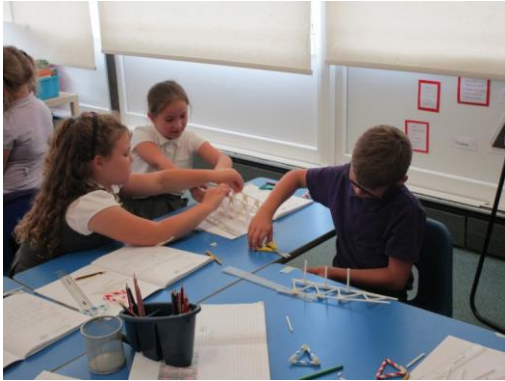
Year 3 Mosaics
