Below are learning ideas that should be completed at home whilst school is closed.

- Handwriting practise for upper and lower case letters.
- Year 1 spelling list – practise spelling these words and then put them into a sentence which your child should record in their books.
- Daily reading. Please see separate sheet for examples of questions to ask your child about their book. They could record their answers in their books using words and pictures.
- Following reading a book, complete a character description. Drawing a picture of the character and then writing sentences to describe that character.
- Create a story map linked to the book that has been read. Then write sentences about the story. Make sure the events are in the correct order. Add in adjectives to describe nouns. Can you include a question and exclamation sentence? Can you use 'and' to join ideas?
- If you watch a good film or TV programme then please record this in your book, writing what it was about and why you enjoyed it.
