Flat Stanley

We have read a story called Flat Stanley by Jeff Brown. In the story, Stanley has many wonderful adventures, including being sent in an envelope to visit friends in California. The class have made their own Flat Stanley and we want to post them off to experience their own adventures. There are two options to this project. We need your help.

Option I: Send Flat Stanley to a friend or relative

Please help your child address the envelope to a friend or relative that would be willing to describe Stanley's visit to their town, state, or far off country and then post Stanley back to your child with an account of his visit. Inside the envelope, you will find a letter with a set of instructions, then post Flat Stanley and the letter to your friend or relative so Flat Stanley can begin his adventure. We would like a postcard, picture, a brochure, or even a video from Stanley describing what he saw while visiting this new place.

Option 2: Take Flat Stanley on an adventure yourself

Some children might want to take their Flat Stanley with them on their own adventure if you are going on holiday or a day visit. Take pictures of your child with Flat Stanley and keep a diary of Flat Stanley's Adventures. If you are not going away then maybe a visit to the travel agent and choose a brochure. Bring the pictures, postcards, brochures, etc. and Flat Stanley back to class when you return. When Stanley returns from his trip, we will post where he went on a map and we will display your child's Flat Stanley.

Lessons in Geography will naturally follow Stanley's return. Try and pick a friend or relative who would be willing to support the educational ideas behind this project. If you want to learn more about Flat Stanley just Google him.

All Flat Stanleys are due back by February 10th 2020.
