School Uniform

As part of the work undertaken to settle the children back into school for the new term, the children, within their respective classrooms, have been working hard to establish various expectations. Part of this work has involved looking at our school uniform and the expectations with regards to what should be worn as established by the Board of Governors.

The uniform, which is supplied by Nationwide School Uniforms, is as follows:-

Boys and Girls School Uniform

- 🔺 **Purple** Sweatshirt or Cardigan
- 🛕 Purple or White Polo Shirt / Shirt / Blouse
- 🔺 **Grey** Trousers, Dress or Skirt
- 🔺 Gingham Summer Dress **Red, Purple** or **Yellow**
- Plain Grey, Black, or White Socks or Tights
- Flat Black Shoes

No trainers, heels, or nail varnish, these are not part of the uniform.

Long hair should be tied up and a thin, plain hairband can be worn.

The school uniform expectations also extend to the PE kit that the children should wear for their PE lessons.

Boys and Girls PE Kit

Please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school at all times.

Indoor Kit:-

- △ Purple T Shirt (no football t-shirts or t-shirts with large logos)
- Navy blue shorts (no football shorts)
- Plimsolls or Trainers.



🛕 As above plus a tracksuit and a coat for colder weather.

All stud earrings and any other jewellery worn with a religious significance should be removed for PE to prevent them from causing in jury.

The above uniform information is also on the school's website.

Any variation to the above is not acceptable. I would appreciate it if you could ensure your child wears correct uniform at all times to help them achieve the expectations that have been set by the ~ Board of Governors and that the children have discussed in class. It will continue to support the statement in our most recent Ofsted Inspection Report: "They wear their uniform with pride".
