Free Dental checks for your child

Your child should have had their first dental check-up before their 1st birthday.

You should then attend regular dental check ups around every 6 months, but this might be every 3 months for some children.

Your children's milk teeth are important and without regular checks from an early age they are at risk of tooth decay.

If your child has a phobia of the dentist or has a Special Educational Need that might stop them from attending a regular dentist then contact Sam Bocock (SENCo) via the school office for more information.

We know there are lots of children who haven't yet seen a dentist. Use the details below to find your closest dentist.
