It is time for the Summer Reading Challenge to take place with Lincolnshire libraries. Lincolnshire's library buildings may have restricted access at present but that's not going to stop Lincolnshire's young readers taking part in this year's Summer Reading Challenge 2021. Due to restrictions, there is a different activity pack to collect from Spalding Library each week to complete at home and join in the fun.

Then visit the Lincolnshire Libraries Facebook and Twitter channels @Lincslibraries and join in the fun there. Library staff have all sorts of wildness planned for the summer. To take part children need to read 6 books over the summer holidays. Children of all ages are invited to take part and they can read anything they like - fact books, stories, joke books or picture books. There are no rules! Every child joining the challenge will receive a membership pack, prizes and on completion of the challenge, a special certificate. The challenge is FREE and The Reading Agency set the challenge each year to encourage children to read for fun during the summer holidays, which is offered through local libraries, and the theme for 2021 is the 'Wild World Heroes'.

Not a member of the library? Pop into the town library on Victoria Street and sign up for free. Members can also access books from Lincolnshire libraries at home through the [Libby](#) by Overdrive eBook platform, details of which are all available through their website.

We will also be running our own school's challenge where you can read any six books from home. Last year, Izzie in Y6 won the prize draw and an Amazon Fire. Whichever challenge you take part in, you will be entered into a prize draw to win an Amazon fire 7 at the end of September. Make a record of the books you read either on a piece of paper or in your Reading Ramble. Your teachers would love to see any Reading Ramble challenges you set yourself linked to one of the books.
