Year 5 - Mobile Planetarium Visit

Science in Term 4 will involve Year 5 being able to answer the question: 'Why is the sun the most important body in the solar system?'

To support us in being able to answer this question, we have arranged for the StarLincs Mobile Planetarium to visit our school on Monday 21st February 2022 to launch our new enquiry. Each class will have an hour session inside the inflatable dome where they will learn about the solar system, how day and night are formed and how the movement of the Earth causes seasonal change. The session will end with a presentation of the constellations of stars that can be seen in the night sky.



This has always been a very popular activity in the past as this is a way of bringing the night sky into the daytime classroom and the host is incredibly knowledgeable about the topic.
