In Term 6, children in Year 4 undertake the national multiplication check so this is a big focus of our Maths learning this year. Fortnightly, the children will be taking part in our Multiplication Mondays, where we will focus on the times tables, one at a time, to help their learning. We will send some activities home for you to do with your child to encourage faster recall of the facts. We would really appreciate your support in this as a quick recall helps in so many areas of maths learning and is a useful skill for future life.
