Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 6 - Relationships, Sex and Health Education Lessons

Following on from my letter in September consulting all parents on the changes to the RSE curriculum, I wrote that there would be an opportunity later in the year to view Year 6 content regarding the right to withdraw your child from Sex Education lessons. This is explained in the Policy which accompanies this letter.

Following on from the consultation there is only one lesson within Year 6 called 'Making Babies' that has content considered Sex Education. This element could be removed from the lesson. There is no right for your child to be withdrawn from the remainder of this lesson as this is classed as Relationships Education which is statutory now in every primary school in England.
