## Year 2 Visit to Lincoln Castle Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2022

As part of our History lessons we have been learning about castles and finding out why William the Conqueror built Lincoln Castle.

We are splitting the year group into two halves. The other half will be visiting on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> June.

We will be doing a walk along the castle wall to learn about the history of the castle and all the names of the parts of the castle. During the walk, the children will have the opportunity to take in the amazing view over Lincoln and stop for a moment to appreciate the view of Lincoln Cathedral.

The children will also see a dragon caught in the wall of the castle and will have the chance to complete a piece of art and some creative activities that will inspire their story writing back in school.

The trip will take place on:

**Monday 27<sup>th</sup> June – leaving at 9:00am and returning at approximately 3.30pm**

There is a voluntary contribution of £22.60 for your child to attend the trip which must be made via Wisepay. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As parent/carer, the cost of other's non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. The children will need to wear school uniform. As we will be outside for most of the day, please ensure that your child has a sun hat, sun cream and a waterproof coat and appropriate footwear for the weather conditions.
