Start of Term 1 – A Very Warm Welcome Back!

I hope that you and your loved ones have kept safe and well over the summer holidays and you have been able to make the most of the lovely weather over the summer to spend time with family and friends.

It has been fantastic to have the children back in school this week – we were very excited to be able to welcome them back on Tuesday. I must also commend the children on their fantastic attitudes to learning following their return to school this week. I have been visiting classrooms



regularly over the course of the week and have been absolutely amazed at just how well the pupils have settled back into the routine of school, faced with new classrooms and in most cases new adults. We look forward to this continuing over the year ahead.

Summer Update

School may have been closed for the summer break however work on the school building and infrastructure has continued. As you may have noticed when you have visited school this week, the Key Stage 2 playgrounds have been resurfaced to ensure that the area where the children play is safe. Currently there are no markings on the playgrounds due to the timings of the work being completed but this is scheduled and should be completed during the October Term Break.

A number of the toilets in school have also been replaced and updated including our Year 3 and 4 toilets and our FS2 and Year 1 toilets. Ensuring that school is a welcoming and pleasant place to be is important to us and obviously the facilities we provide is one element of this.

Over the course of the summer our server, which supports our IT infrastructure has also been replaced with the school now moving to a cloud based model. This is part of a wider IT modernisation project that the Trust is currently implementing across the whole trust and this has also resulted in email addresses across the school being updated. In a morning the gates will open at 8.30am to allow time to get onto site ready for doors opening at 8.35am (KS2) and close at 8.55am. In an afternoon the site will open at 3.05pm.

This operates from 7.30am each morning till the start of the school day and from 3.10pm in an afternoon until 5.45pm. Uniform

We look forward to welcoming the pupils back to school, looking extremely smart in their uniforms, however we have made the decision that pupils can still wear PE kit for identified PE days. This does need to be school PE kit as per school policy. Please ensure pupils are not wearing earrings on PE days. Teachers in school are currently just finalising their timetables and as such PE days will be confirmed by Year Groups early next week. Year Groups will also display a poster of this information in their classroom windows so please look out for this. Please do make sure uniform is named as this will mean it can be easily returned if mislaid. If you do have any queries regarding uniform, please get in touch.

Attendance

We cannot stress enough the importance of excellent attendance alongside punctuality, as it can impact so much on the achievement and progress over the course of a school year. If a child is late into school they may miss key teaching at the start of lessons which can also unsettle them for the rest of the day. Where attendance levels are a concern this can also influence the progress children make.

We will continue to monitor attendance rigorously over the course of the school year and ask for your support in ensuring pupils attend regularly and on time. This will ensure that they do not miss any vital learning and supports your child in ensuring they reach their potential. COVID-19 Guidance:

Whilst we are hopefully looking forward to an uninterrupted school year, it is clear that COVID-19 remains with us. However, the current guidance remains very much the same as it was prior to the summer break. If you do have any questions around this please do not hesitate to get in touch.

From 1st April 2022 the guidance around COVID and testing has been amended, as was previously outlined on the COVID road map and our transition into 'Living with COVID'.

Covid is now specifically referenced in the guidance around the control of infectious diseases and there is no separate COVID guidance. Section 3 is related to management of infectious diseases, COVID being detailed within the section about Respiratory Infections. Section 4 of this guidance references actions to be taken should there be an 'outbreak'.

Essentially – COVID will be treated as we would any other infectious illness. Staff and children will be encouraged to stay at home if they are unwell. Where there is a positive COVID test, the timescales as below are advised:

• 5 days for staff and 3 days for pupils.



Further to the above, children/staff with a temperature, should not return to school/work whilst they still have a temperature, but can return with mild cold symptoms and if they are otherwise well enough to be at school/work.

Keeping Us Informed

There have obviously been a number of changes in school since we finished in July and know that there are likely to be changes within families too.

If anything has changed, you've moved house, changed your mobile number, your child has been diagnosed with a condition or an allergy etc., please let us know asap so that we can ensure the information we hold for your child is current and up to date. We have carried over permission for walking to school from the previous academic year, however if this has changed, please get in touch.

Parents/carers are obviously welcome to come and speak to the office, however please remember that SLT are on the playground on a morning/afternoon to enable a face to face conversation. Please also feel free to discuss any questions, concerns or queries about your child with their class adults, they will be more than happy to help.
