## Y3EP Walk to Ayscough fee Gardens

As part of our English learning this term we will be creating our own information leaflets about Ayscoughfee Gardens. For the children to be able to create an accurate and detailed text we are thrilled to let you know that we will be taking all children in Y3EP to Ayscoughfee Gardens on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> April during the afternoon.
