Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 4 Trip – Skegness and Chapel St. Leonards Monday 20th March 2023

In our Geography learning this term, we are considering the question 'What makes a good seaside?' We will have looked at the physical and human aspects of coastal regions and compared a commercialised and natural beach.

To further our learning, we are intending to go and do some fieldwork on Monday 20th March. We will leave school at 9.00am and head to Skegness where we will look at the features we can see in a commercialised seaside. We will then have a picnic lunch before moving on to Chapel St. Leonards, a natural beach. Whilst there we will compare and contrast the two different coastal locations and further consider and make notes on 'What makes a good seaside?' We will return to school at 3.15pm in time for the end of the day.

The children will need a snack and a drink for when we arrive, a packed lunch for later and a towel/blanket to sit on while on the beach. The children will also need to be dressed appropriately for the weather conditions on the day. The children should come in wellington boots, or suitable waterproof footwear. They should also bring a named carrier bag with clean footwear to change into when we have finished on the beach.

As already mentioned, all children will need a packed lunch and drink with them for the trip – please don't order a hot meal for this day. If you are entitled to Free School Meals, we can provide your child with a packed lunch for this trip which will include a sandwich, fresh fruit, cake and water; please complete the choice of sandwich filling on the separate form sent with your child. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch from home, please indicate this on the form.

The cost of the coach for the trip is £7.59. Please make the payment via ParentPay and return the slip below by Friday 15th March giving permission for your child to come on the trip. We are looking forward to enhancing our learning through this fieldwork.
