Year 1 History Workshop - Tuesday 4th October 2022

As part of the Year One Curriculum, in our History lessons, we will be studying the lives of Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole. We are fortunate to have secured a visit from the Crew company who will be holding a History Workshop in school. Children will need to be in their school uniform for the workshop.

This workshop examines the lives of these two important Victorian women. The children explore how both women arrived in Crimea and the work they performed that won them the admiration and respect of the soldiers and why we still remember them today. This is all explored with the children becoming the two principal women, the soldiers, orderlies, officers etc. through costume, drama and props.
