Educational Visit to Peterborough Museum – Really Roman Day Monday 22nd January 2024

This term our History curriculum in Year 3 focuses on the 'Roman' period. As part of this topic, we are excited to be offering the children the chance to spend a day at Peterborough Museum on **Monday 22nd January 2024**.

The Vivacity Peterborough Museum Education Service has arranged various activities throughout the day to experience what life was like during the Roman period including a session handling Roman pottery, meeting a Roman surgeon and discovering what life was like in a Roman settlement. It will be an exciting day which will bring the 'Roman' period to life for the children. It will also help the children to understand the chronological progression from the Iron Age into the Roman period.

The bus will leave at 9:00am so we ask that the children arrive promptly at 8:35am for registration. They will return to school for approximately 3:00pm. There is a voluntary contribution of £16.75 for your child to attend the trip, including transport, which must be made via ParentPay. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As a parent/carers, the cost of other's non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. If you have difficulties in making the payment, please make an appointment to speak to Diane Mulley or member of the Senior Leadership Team.

The children will need to wear school uniform including school shoes. Most of the day will be spent inside however, please ensure that your child comes to school with a coat.

PACKED LUNCH – All children will need a packed lunch and drink with them for the trip – please don't order a hot meal for this day.

If you are entitled to Free School Meals, we can provide your child with a packed lunch for this trip which will include a sandwich, fresh fruit, cake and water; please complete the choice of sandwich filling on the separate form sent with your child. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch from home, please indicate this on the form.
