## Year 2 Visit to Lincoln Castle Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> September 2023

As part of our History topic this term, we will be learning about castles and finding out why William the Conqueror built Lincoln Castle.

We will be doing a walk along the castle wall to learn about the history of the castle and identify the parts of the castle. During the walk, the children will have the opportunity to take in the amazing view over Lincoln and stop for a moment to appreciate the view of Lincoln Cathedral. We will also go into the Cathedral to compare the building with the castle.

The children will also see a dragon caught in the wall of the castle and will have the chance to complete a piece of art and some creative activities that will inspire their story writing back in school.

The trip will take place on:

### Thursday 21st September – leaving at 9:00am and returning at approximately 3.15pm
