WOW DAYS

As part of our journey, this term we will be thinking about where we are in the world and comparing England to different countries including those that have contrasting landscapes and climates.

WOW Days

In order to enhance the children's learning experience, we would like to schedule in 2 WOW days. Our plan is that we make our own mini passports with the children that they will use on the WOW days. On the first WOW day we will board our pretend aeroplane, Parish Planes, and journey to the North Pole. On both of these days the children may come in non-school uniform BUT wearing clothes that would be appropriate for the climate that we are visiting (please see below for more information).

- **Tuesday 5th March**

Destination - The North and South Pole!

Non-school uniform for a cold climate.

One bag to take on the plane (this can be a small suitcase) with what they would take on a trip to a cold country.

All bags will have a label attached to them at school as they are loaded onto the plane.

We will explore ice and create experiments and also learn about different animals that can be found in these cold habitats.

- **Tuesday 19th March**

Destination - Africa and Mali!

Non-school uniform for a hot climate.

One bag (this can be a small suitcase) with what they would take on a trip to a hot country.

Creative day - please ensure that the clothes they wear are ok to get dirty!

Please note that we will still put coats etc on to complete our outdoor learning should we need to.

We will explore how heat impacts different materials (including chocolate).
