Y5IG Parent Consultation and Report Update

I am writing to share with you your child's report for Terms 3 and 4. You will find the usual commentary explaining what your child has achieved and future targets in relation to the National Curriculum. As you will know staff in school are continually assessing your child against the expectations of the National Curriculum and our internal key performance indicators. As part of this we have been undertaking moderation activities within school across Year Groups and Phases. This is reflected within the report with assessment against both the objectives taught this academic year and also against the Year Group expectations at this point in the year. I would like to take this opportunity to thank your child for their hard work and commitment during this academic year so far and hope they will similarly rise to the challenge during Terms 5 and 6 as they prepare for the transition to Year 6 next year and secondary school shortly after.

As you will know we had intended to share these with parents and carers at our Spring Parent/Carer Consultation meetings held last week however, unfortunately these did need to be postponed for Y5IG due to illness. It has always been our intention to rearrange the Parent Consultation meetings once staff were back in school. However, you will also know that Mrs Imogen Gold is due to start her maternity leave directly after the Easter break with Miss Maddie Arnold taking responsibility for the class for the remainder of the academic year. As a school we do feel it is important that she has some time to get to know the pupils and, with this in mind, we propose to hold Parent Consultation meetings on Tuesday 7th May throughout the school day. Consultations will be attended by Maddie Arnold, as Class Teacher, and also Emily Hill, Deputy Head Teacher, or Charlotte Hardy, Assistant Head Teacher and SENCo. This will allow parents and carers to meet the class teacher more formally and for her to share her initial findings. Emily and Charlotte will also be able to share feedback from Imogen Gold, ensuring that all parents and carers have a secure overview of the year so far, including their child's achievements and subsequent next steps.

Further details will follow after the Term Break regarding the booking of appointments and to formalise arrangements. In the meantime, I know you will join with me in wishing Imogen Gold well over the coming months and also in welcoming Maddie Arnold to the Spalding Parish family.
