Educational Visit to Nene Outdoors – Investigating Rivers Wednesday 2nd July 2025 (Y3SD and Y3TS) Thursday 3rd July 2025 (Y3KR)

Our Geography topic in Year 3 focuses on investigating rivers. As part of this topic, we are excited to be offering the children the chance to spend a day at Nene Outdoors Education Centre in Peterborough on:

- Wednesday 2nd July Y3SD and Y3TS
 - Thursday 3rd July 2025 Y3KR

The Nene Outdoors Education Centre has arranged various activities throughout the day to investigate Living Rivers, including carrying out a river study on a section of the river and developing their map reading skills to follow a route along the river, locating points of interest and discussing the physical and human processes influencing the river environment. It will be an exciting day which will bring the study of Rivers to life. We will be using this as a vehicle for first handwriting opportunities and other cross curricular links throughout our Learning Journey.

The bus will leave at **9.00am** so we ask that the children arrive promptly at **8:35am** for registration. They will return to school for approximately **3:00pm**.

There is a voluntary contribution of £11.84 for your child to attend the trip, including transport. Please make the payment on MCAS and complete the permission form. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As a parent/carer, the cost of other's non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. If you have difficulties in making the payment, please make an appointment to speak to Emily Hill or Diane Mulley. **All payments are to be made on MCAS, and reply slips returned, by Friday 20th June 2025.**

The children will need to wear school uniform for the trip. As most of the day will be spent outside please ensure that your child has a waterproof coat and appropriate footwear for the weather conditions. We would advise that girls wear trousers and if the weather is particularly warm that children wear hats and apply suncream before they arrive at school.
