## **Year 4 Visit to The Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham Wednesday 25th June and Thursday 26th June 2025**

As part of our RE topic this term, we will be learning about pilgrimage. To link with this, we are excited to be offering the children the chance to spend a day at The Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, in Walsingham.

This medieval place of pilgrimage, which rivalled Canterbury, was visited by thousands of pilgrims from across Britain and Europe. Walsingham became known as 'England's Nazareth' because of the nature of the vision which the Lady Richeldis experienced. In the modern era, the past 100 years have witnessed the dramatic restoration of pilgrimage to Walsingham.

The Education Department is dedicated to providing opportunities to promote students' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development through curriculum-based programmes with a special emphasis on Christian faith.

The trip will take place on:

**Wednesday 25th June – Y4SH and 14 members of Y4SS  
Thursday 26th June - Y4LB and remaining members of Y4SS**

The coach will leave school at 9am and will return at approximately 4pm.

There is a voluntary contribution of £12.53 for your child to attend the trip which must be made via MCAS. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As parent/carers, the cost of other's non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. If you have difficulties in making the payment, please book an appointment with Diane Mulley or a member of the SLT.

The children will need to wear school uniform. As we will be outside for most of the day, please ensure that your child has a sun hat/sun cream and a waterproof coat and appropriate footwear for the weather conditions.
