Dear Parent/Carer,

Year 3 – Really Roman Day at Peterborough Museum Wednesday 7th January 2026

In term three, our History curriculum in Year 3 focuses on the 'Roman' period. As part of this topic, we are excited to offer the children the chance to spend a day at Peterborough Museum.

The Vivacity Peterborough Museum Education Service has arranged various activities throughout the day to experience what life was like during the Roman period, including a session handling Roman pottery, meeting a Roman surgeon and discovering what life was like in a Roman settlement. It will be an exciting day which will bring the 'Roman' period to life for the children and will also help them to understand the chronological progression from the Iron Age into the Roman period.

The bus will leave at 9:00am so we ask that the children arrive promptly for registration. They will return to school for approximately 3:20pm. There is a voluntary contribution of £15.32 for your child to attend the trip, which includes transport. Payment must be made via MCAS. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As a parent/carer, the cost of others' non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. If you have difficulties in making the payment, please make an appointment to speak to Diane Mulley or a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

The children will need to wear school uniform on the day.

PACKED LUNCH – All children will need a packed lunch and drink for the trip. When you order your child's lunches for next term, please make your selection a sandwich for the day of the trip. The packed lunch option will include a sandwich, fresh fruit, a yogurt or cake and water. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch from home, please do not book a hot meal for the day of the trip.

TRAVEL SICKNESS MEDICATION – If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure you give them the necessary medication before they come to school. We can give them a second tablet later in the day, before the journey home, however, we will need you to complete a consent form. Please indicate on the reply slip if you require us to do this, you will then be given a Medication Form to complete before the day of the trip.
