Dear Parent/Carer,

EYFS – Tattershall Farm Park Friday 17th July 2026

As part of our Science topic last term, we have been learning about different animals and their young. To support our learning, we are excited to take the children to Tattershall Farm Park where they will see a range of animals from common farm animals and popular pets to interesting insects and reptiles. This includes animals such as cows, sheep, pigs, goats and chickens. We will be getting close to the animals and will possibly even help to feed calves and lambs in the animal barn, during an interactive and educational 'Meet the Animals' session. The children will also have the opportunity to take a goat for a walk and explore the nature area looking for different insects.

The bus will leave at 9:00am so we ask that the children arrive promptly at 8:30am for registration. They will return to school for approximately 3:00pm. There is a voluntary contribution of **£15.97** for your child to attend the trip, which includes transport. Payment must be made via MCAS. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As a parent/carers, the cost of others' non-payment does not get passed on to you. **Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead.** If you have difficulties in making the payment, please make an appointment to speak to Diane Mulley or member of the Senior Leadership Team.

The children will need to wear school uniform. As most of the day will be spent outside, please ensure that your child has appropriate clothing and footwear for the weather conditions. We would advise that the children wear trousers.

PACKED LUNCH – All children will need a packed lunch and drink for the trip. If you have already ordered a hot meal for your child, please amend your selection to a sandwich option via MCAS before Tuesday 7th July. The packed lunch option will include a sandwich, fresh fruit, a yogurt or cake and water. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch from home, please cancel any existing meal bookings for the day of the trip by the date above.

TRAVEL SICKNESS MEDICATION – If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure you give them the necessary medication before they come to school. We can give them a second tablet later in the day, before the journey home, however, we will need you to complete a consent form. Please indicate
