Year 4 Visit to Peterborough Cathedral – Searching for Saxons Workshop
Tuesday 14th October 2025 (Y4KB)
Thursday 16th October 2025 (Y4SH and Y4TS)

In History this term, we will be learning about the Anglo Saxons. As part of this topic, we are excited to be offering the children the chance to spend a day at Peterborough Cathedral on Tuesday 14th October (Y4KB) and Thursday 16th October (Y4SH and Y4TS).

During the visit, children will view a range of Anglo Saxon Artefacts and learn more about life in Anglo Saxon Britain. It will be an exciting day which will bring the 'Anglo Saxon' period to life for the children.

The trip will take place on:

Tuesday 14th October (Y4KB) – leaving at 9:00am and returning at approximately 3.15pm Thursday 16th October (Y4SH and Y4TS) – leaving at 9:00am and returning at approximately 3:15pm

There is a voluntary contribution of £13.00 for your child to attend the trip which must be made via the MCAS App. The cost is based on all children attending and payment being made. As parent/carer, the cost of other's non-payment does not get passed on to you. Although, this is a voluntary contribution, we must stress that a shortfall in contributions may prevent the trip from going ahead. If you have difficulties in making the payment, please book an appointment with Diane Mulley or a member of the SLT.

The children will need to wear school uniform.

PACKED LUNCH - All children will need a packed lunch and drink with them for the trip — please don't order a hot meal for this day. If you are entitled to Free School Meals, we can provide your child with a packed lunch for this trip which will include a sandwich, fresh fruit, biscuit and drink; please complete the choice of sandwich filling on the separate form sent with your child. Your child will still need to bring a drink and snack with them. If you would prefer to provide a packed lunch from home, please indicate this on the form.

TRAVEL SICKNESS – If your child is prone to travel sickness, please ensure they take any necessary medication before the journey. You may also wish to provide suitable travel sickness tablets for the return trip, clearly labelled with your child's name and dosage instructions. If you have any concerns or specific instructions, please let your class teacher know in advance so we can support your child appropriately during travel.

Please make your payment and give consent via MCAS by Friday 10th October.
