

Rock around the Ages... Stone Age to Iron Age

Year 3

Terms 1 and 2

Let's take a tour through Pre- History and discover what life was like.

English

We will be looking at describing characters and settings through the stories The Tunnel, The Stone Age Boy and The Return. The children will be writing their own autumn story using the language features taught in Term 1. The Stone Age to the Iron Age will be used as a vehicle to create their own non-fiction writing.

French

The children will learn to count to 20, say the names of animals and colour words.

Science

We will be learning about rocks and soils and the properties of them.

Art/DT

We will be developing the skills of sketching and shading. We will also be using collage materials to represent animals from the Stone Age by creating a range of textures. The children will be using clay to create clay sculptures.

History

The children will be finding out about the prehistoric periods the Stone Age, Bronze and Iron Age.

Mathematics

Beginning with Place Value the children will learn the value of the numbers and use this knowledge to learn new methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will also develop their knowledge of fractions.

P.E

For outdoor P.E. the children will be learning the skills involved in Invasion Games.
For indoor lessons they will be working on curling, stretching and arching.

RE

God – Hinduism
We will find out how deities and key figures are described in Hindu sacred texts and stories.

P.S.H.E.

In these sessions they will learn about caring for each other and encouraging someone to try.
