Europe	The sixth largest continent in size and the third largest in population. It is bordered by the Mediterranean Sea to the south, Asia to the east, and the Atlantic Ocean to the West.	Region	A large area of land that is different from other areas of land, for example because it is one of the different parts of a country with its own customs and characteristics, or because it has a particular geographical feature.
Human Characteristics	Human features are things that are built by humans such as bridges and roads.	Locate	If you locate something, you find out where it is.
Physical Characteristics	Physical features show. natural objects such as mountains and rivers.	Climate Zone	Areas into which the Earth can be divided depending on its climate or weather patterns.
