

1820 - Florence Nightingale was born on 12th May in Italy. 1837—Florence's family were rich. Her family set off with their servants for a tour of Europe. 1854—Florence went to Scutari in Turkey to nurse soldiers who were sick in the Crimean War.

1910—Florence died 13th August 1910.

1837—Florence felt God had spoken to her and asked her to work for Him. 1853—Florence was asked to be in charge of a hospital for the sick women in London.

1907—Florence became the first woman to receive the order of Merit which honoured her

<u>How did Florence Nightingale improve the hospital in Scutari:</u>

- She brought in new beds and got rid of the old, dirty ones.
- New clothing and bedding
- Used better medicines and clean water
- She got rid of rats and rotten food.

<u>How did Mary Seacole use different medicines to help</u> <u>the sick soldiers:</u>

- Using a pestle and mortar to crush ginger for the treatment of diarrhoea.
- Crushing lemon grass to help with a fever.
- Using fresh Aloe Vera to rub on cuts and bruises.
