World Book Day — Thursday 4th March 2021 (We will not be dressing up this year.)

Join us online and in school to celebrate authors, illustrators, books and (most importantly) a celebration of reading. In fact, it's the biggest celebration of its kind, designated by UNESCO as a worldwide celebration of books and reading and marked in over 100 countries all over the world. This is the 24th year there's been a World Book Day and on **Thursday 4th March** children of all ages will come together to appreciate reading.

The main aim of World Book Day in the UK and Ireland is to encourage children to explore the pleasures of books and reading by providing them with the opportunity to have a book of their own.

As part of World Book Day, the children will have the opportunity to take part in a range of exciting activities based around reading during the day.

Each child will be given a book and a voucher (in the next two weeks) to take to a local bookseller and can use it to pick one of THIRTEEN (exclusive, new and completely free) books. Or, if they'd rather, they can use it to get £1 off any book or audio book costing over £2.99 at a participating bookshop or book club when they open again.
